Students with high school study only (no AP/IB/AICE):

Background	You may enroll in
No background in French or French 1 in grades 9-12 <i>(no need to take SATII exam after registering)</i>	FRE 1130
Highest course French 2 in grades 9-12 <i>(no need to take SATII exam after registering)</i>	FRE 1134
Students who fall in the categories below <u>MUST</u> take the SATII (see below)	
Highest course French 3 or 4 in grades 9-12	FRE 2200 (SAT II required to confirm placement)

FRE 1130: Beginning French 1 (5 credits)

FRE 1131: Beginning French 2 (5 credits)

FRE 1134: Accelerated French Review (5 credits)

2. SAT II score distribution for French: Score of 500 and below: consult the Director of Beginning French, Dr. Theresa A. Antes (antes@ufl.edu) for placement advice. 500-520: register in FRE 2220; your CLAS language requirement is complete. 520 and above: consult with the Undergraduate coordinator in French, Dr. Brigitte Weltman-Aron (bweltman@ufl.edu) for placement advice.
