

Announcement of Conner Scholarships in French and Francophone Studies for Study Abroad

(Spring 2024 and Summer 2024 programs)

The Wayne Conner fund for the Advancement of French and Francophone Studies will offer scholarships to worthy students planning to study abroad. These scholarships are given to undergraduate students majoring (double major and dual degree students are eligible) in French and Francophone Studies, with preference for those attending a UF sponsored study abroad program. A faculty review committee will select the awardee based on their academic performance and involvement in the French and Francophone Studies Program. Students will be recognized at the LLC annual award ceremony in April.

On a separate page, please write a short essay in English or French in which you explain the reasons why the study abroad program to which you are applying would be of particular interest and benefit to you.
