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Course description

SSW 3303 serves as the 4th year of Swahili and, therefore, it is appropriate for those students who have taken Advanced Swahili (SWA 3410/3411) or have equivalent level of study or proficiency. It continues from where SWA 3411 ends. It concentrates on developing the learner's ability to participate effectively in most formal and informal communicative interactions on practical, social, professional and abstract topics as well as the ability to support opinions and hypothesize using native-like discourse strategies. It specifically focuses on Swahili oral literature – including theoretical issues, exploring and surveying various types of Swahili oral literature including folktales, fables, poetry, propitiatory offerings, proverbs, riddles, and the like, and their role in contemporary society.

Course objectives

Students should be able to participate actively and react to others (face-to-face interactions, presentational speaking & writing), appropriately in academic debates (formal or informal), providing some facts and rationales to back up their views/opinions/statements.
