Electronic copies of the proposals are due to me by April 1, 2026 - please send to jrea@ufl.edu by 5 pm and will consist of:

- one page abstract of your plans for study/travel
- one page budget outlining expenses
- one page list of other sources of funding available to support your trip. Graduate students be sure to apply for the Grant and/or Benario awards through CAMWS: <http://www.camws.org/awards/sgb.php>
- the attached cover page

Priority will be given to students who have not traveled to Italy before.

Eligibility is limited to:

- undergraduates who have declared the major or minor in Classics (any track)
- currently enrolled graduate students in the Department of Classics who will be enrolled full time in Fall 2026.

The maximum amount of any one award will be \$2000; the number of awards granted will depend on the quality and quantity of proposals received.

Proposals will be judged on the basis of academic qualifications, feasibility of study abroad proposal, and financial need.

You will be notified the week of April 6th and will receive your award at the Departmental ceremony at the end of the semester.
