

## Foreign Languages and Literatures – Dual Languages Specialization (FDU)

- Students interested in FDU must first meet with the undergraduate coordinators of the two languages they select and work out a semester-by-semester plan. Once they add FDU as a major, they are expected to follow the plan. Any changes must be approved by the undergraduate coordinators.
