
Course Objectives

This course is a continuation of JPN 2230 Intermediate Japanese 1 and covers "*Genki II*" Lessons 22 through 23 and "*Tobira*" Lesson 1 through 4. It is designed to further enhance students' four language skills in listening, speaking, reading and writing. Moreover, this course will prepare students to demonstrate their proficiencies across the three communication modes: interpretive, interpersonal, and presentational with an emphasis on communicative language use that also reveals features of Japanese cultures. By the end of the course, students are expected to reach an intermediate-mid, or higher, level of proficiency as defined by the ACTFL (American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages) Proficiency Guidelines. You must attain a letter grade of C or higher, which is a composite score of 73 or higher, or instructor's permission to continue in JPN 3410.

Prerequisites:

Three semesters of university-level study of Beginning Japanese and Intermediate Japanese 1 (JPN 1130, 1113, and 2230 at UF), or the equivalent, are required. You must have attained a grade of C or higher in JPN 2230 or the instructor's permission to enroll in this course.

If you are a new student in the Japanese language program at the University of Florida, you must take and pass the placement exam in order to be allowed to enroll by your instructor, space permitting. REQUIREMENTS AND POLICIES

Required Hardware and Software

To access this institute in Canvas, you will need access to the Internet and a <u>supported browser</u>. You will need to have a webcam and a headset (headphones with a microphone) for full participation. If you have a newer laptop or tablet, you may already have an integrated webcam; however, if you have trouble with echo and feedback, you will need to use a headset or earbuds.

1. Preparation for the class

The daily schedule, which follows below, is designed for you to prepare the materials indicated for a given date **BEFORE** the class meetings. You are expected to come to class well prepared so that you will be ready to participate in communication activities in a meaningful context with your instructor and classmates. This is an intensive language course for which you will receive five credit hours. Therefore, you are expected to study for the course **at least two hours every day** outside of the class. These two hours include time for you to:

- 1) read the textbook carefully,
- 2) watch grammar explanation videos,
- 3) complete Prep HW,
- 4) do the textbook activities,

- 5) complete other homework assignments,
- 6) memorize vocabulary and kanji, and
- 7) review materials.

Read the assigned pages carefully, listen to the audio files online, and bring any questions you had while studying for the class since they may benefit your classmates as well! Completing homework alone is not sufficient preparation to perform well in class. If you do not know how to prepare for the class, please ask the instructor or refer to the study guide in the course packet.

2. Attendance and participation

Attendance and active participation in class are mandatory and will be recorded at each class session. Foreign language learning is a cumulative process, and it is very important that you come to class and practice Japanese every day. Grading criteria for participation will be on a 10-point scale. To receive full participation credit, you must show evidence of preparation for class. However, this is not to say that you cannot make mistakes; trial and error is the only way to learn how to use the language, and you are encouraged to try out the new structures, make errors, and learn from them. Active participation that shows your effort will count towards the participation grade. On the contrary, no participation will seriously hurt your participation grade. You will receive 0 points when you are absent from a class.

Students are permitted three unexcused absences during the semester. At the 4th absence, you will lose 3% from the final grade. 2.1. Zoom Presence Policy

Participation in our class is fundamental since improving oral conversation skills is a key objective of the course. Thus, students are required to have their cameras on from start to finish during our classes on Zoom. A default setting for our sessions in Zoom is that participants will be muted when they enter, so you will unmute yourself when you comment orally during our whole-group conversations and when you are in small groups. Your instructor may also ask students to reply in the chat box for specific activities. Oral comments on camera and written comments in the chat box are considered activities for participation. If you have technical issues, please immediately consult UF IT Help to resolve them and then contact your instructor. Zoom sessions will not be recorded by the instructor and may not be recorded by students. As in all courses, unauthorized recording and unauthorized sharing of recorded material is prohibited

2.2. Policy Regarding Make-Up Quizzes or Exams

Make-up guizzes or exams may be scheduled ONLY when pre-approved by the instructor, or in the case of documented illness or emergency. It is your responsibility to contact your instructor immediately after returning to class and schedule make-up guizzes/exams within 2 class days, or no make-up will be allowed.

3. Homework

We have two types of daily homework: (a) Prep HW and (b) workbook/other daily homework. Students are expected to complete all assigned homework **BEFORE class begins** on the due date indicated in the schedule. Prep HW should be submitted by 11:59pm on the day before indicated in the schedule.

3.1. Prep HW (Preparation Homework) and Review HW

Read the textbook carefully and complete Prep HW first before doing other homework assignments. Make sure that you focus on materials of the day which is indicated in the name of its Canvas Quiz. Prep HW will give you a good starting foundation of the specific materials you are going to learn and practice at home and then in the classroom.

You will receive 1 homework point for a completed Prep HW as the policy describes below. This means that even if you cannot get a full Canvas Quiz score, as long as you complete Prep HW as instructed, you will receive 1 homework point for a Prep HW.

You will receive Canvas Quiz score as homework points for Review HW. It is not 1 point. However, you can take the Review HW quiz as many times as you want.

For Question 1 of Prep HW, please don't write the same thing over and over. For example, you cannot write, "I learned how to ABC. The most important is to keep practicing this structure and incorporate it in daily conversations in Japanese." every time.

Workbook/other daily homework is always to be self-corrected using the Answer Key. You must use a <u>different</u> color ink (any color but red) to do self-correction so it will be easy for the instructor to see. You can find the Answer Key in "Files" on e-Learning.

<u>Please put a check mark next to every single item or make a correction</u>. <u>Each day the homework Answer Key includes at least one wrong answer that should be quite obvious. Please identify and mark those wrong answers when you do self-correction</u>. <u>Otherwise you will not receive homework credit.</u>

3.3. Workbook/Other Daily Homework – Submission Attachment File Types

All Canvas Assignment uploads (Kanji worksheet for example) must be in either PDF or JPEG format. Your instructor checks your assignments and provides individualized feedback daily. To do your best, it is essential to check your grades on Canvas every day and take advantage of the learnings in the feedback given.

3.4. Daily Homework Points

Note that 1pt. is the maximum point you can receive for <u>each category</u> (a workbook page, writing/composition practice, etc.). In addition to on-time delivery of assignments, quality will also be evaluated. There is <u>no partial</u> point.

If you have a specific question or exercise that you want your instructor to check, please make a note of it. Otherwise, the instructor will spot-check students' self-corrected homework.

3.5 Quiz Self-Correction (Bonus Point)

<u>Upon return of a quiz in class, you may do self-correction and turn it in the following day as a part of homework.</u> <u>If you can correct ALL errors on quizzes, 1 point will be added to the quiz score.</u> Please write SC (self-corrected) at the top of the first page. Do not staple the self-corrected quiz to the regular homework.

4. Japanese Speaking Policy in Class

You have a very limited exposure to Japanese outside of the class, and it is very important that you make every use of the precious opportunities to speak Japanese in class. Therefore, you are required to speak only Japanese in class. You will sign an honor pledge at the beginning of the term regarding speaking only Japanese in class. You have been explicitly taught how to ask permission to speak English (英語で質問があります Or 英語で話してもよろしいでしょうか), if it becomes absolutely necessary. Please understand that if the instructor denies permission, it is for a specific reason that will be explained to you after class. A limited amount of English will be used by the instructor to explain grammar in class, at the discretion of the instructor.
